## The Lost Sheep

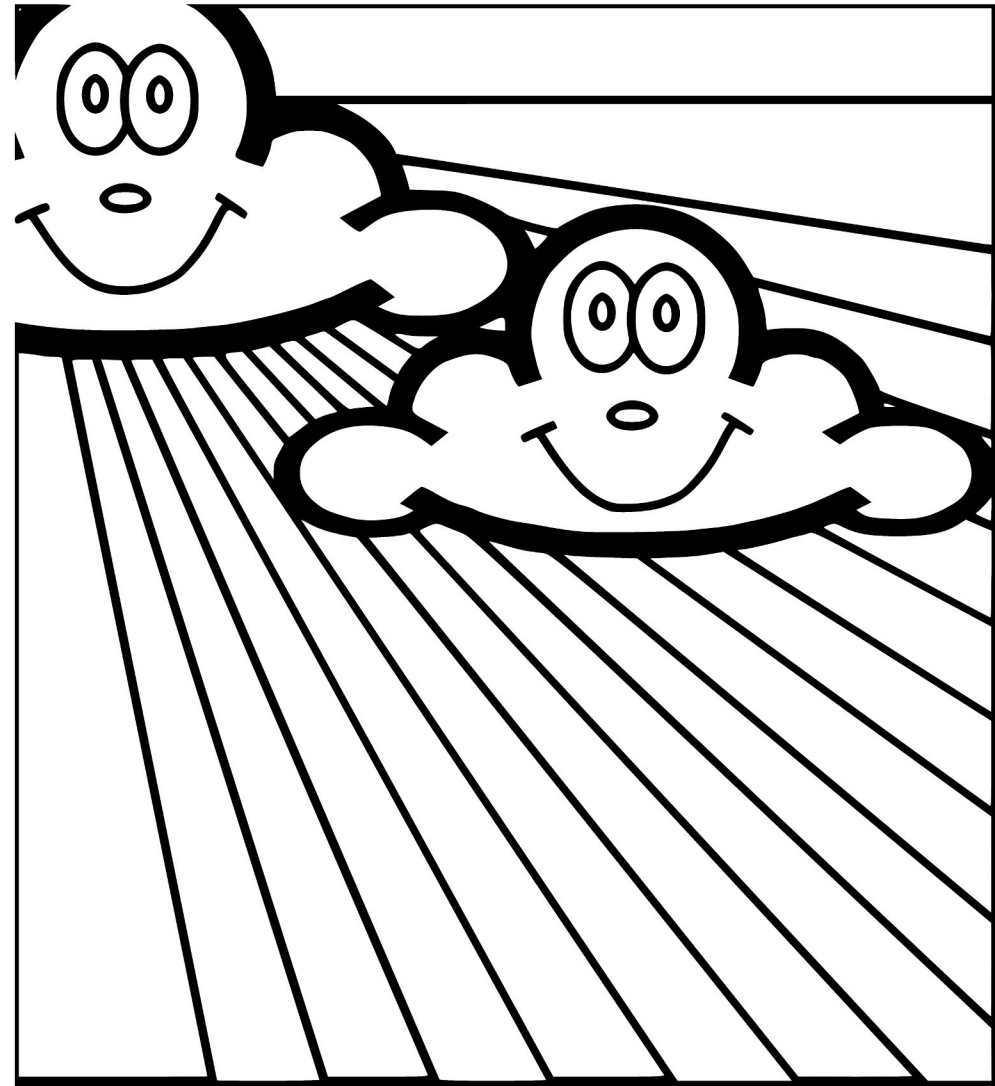
A shepherd had a hundred sheep and one of them went wandering away.

He left the 99 other sheep in the paddock and went searching for the sheep that was lost until he found it.

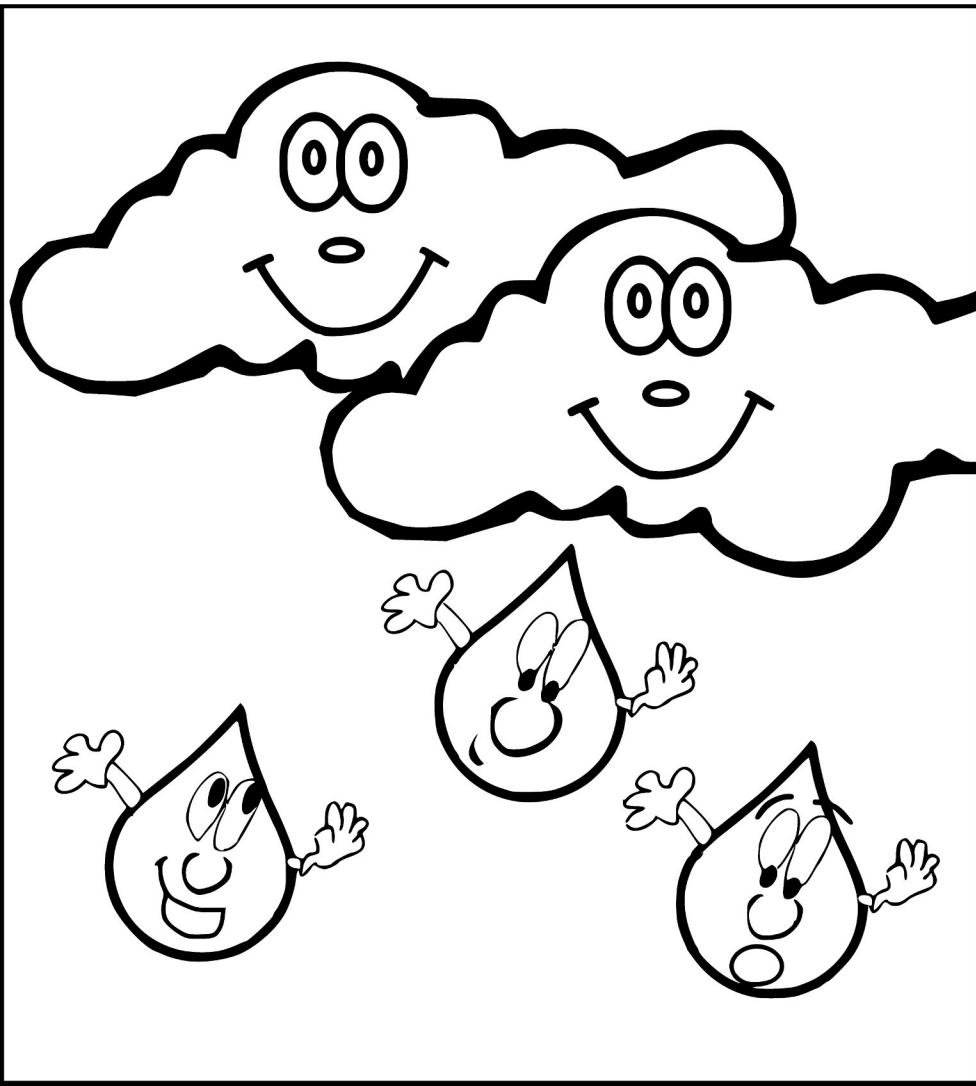
When he came home, he called all his friends and neighbours to celebrate: "the sheep that was lost is now found!"

A woman had some valuable coins and one of them was lost. She looked all over the house to find it, sweeping and looking under all the cushions.

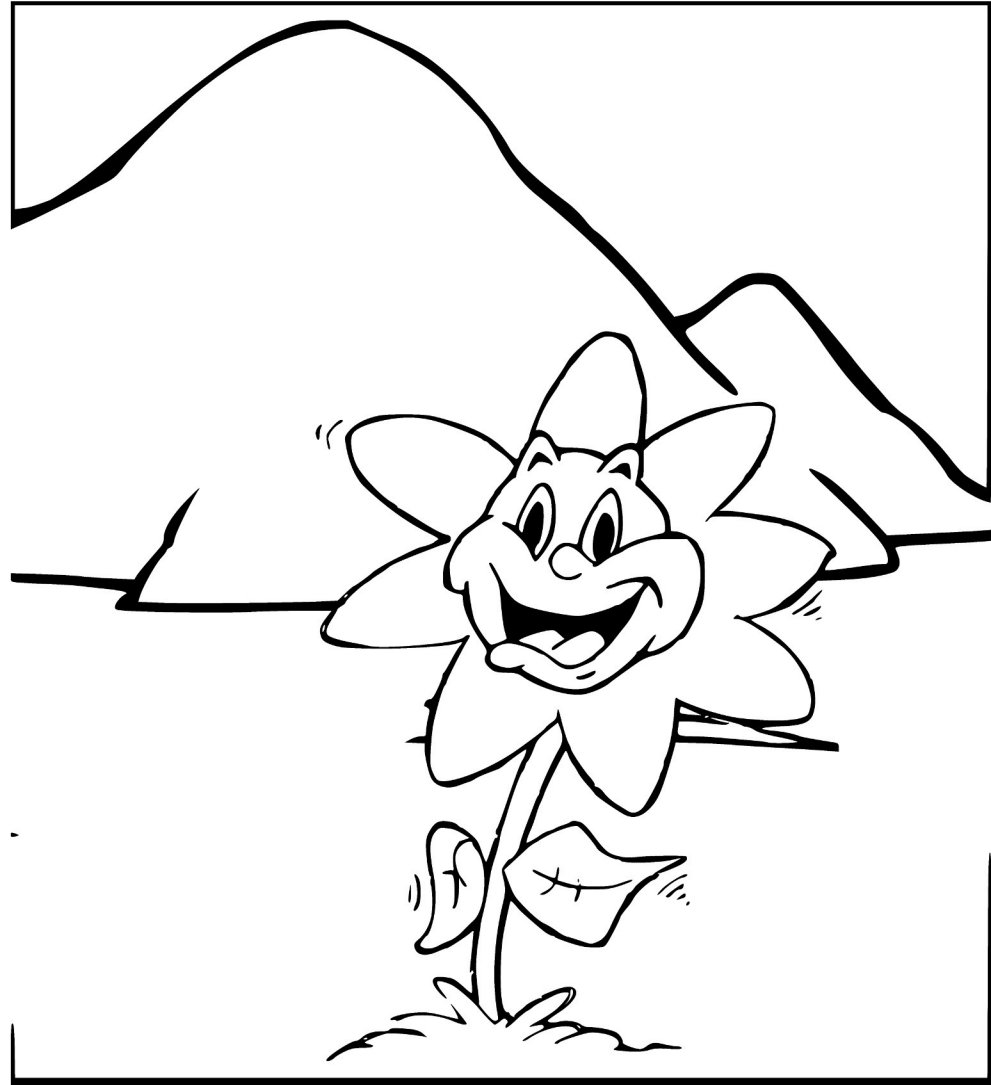
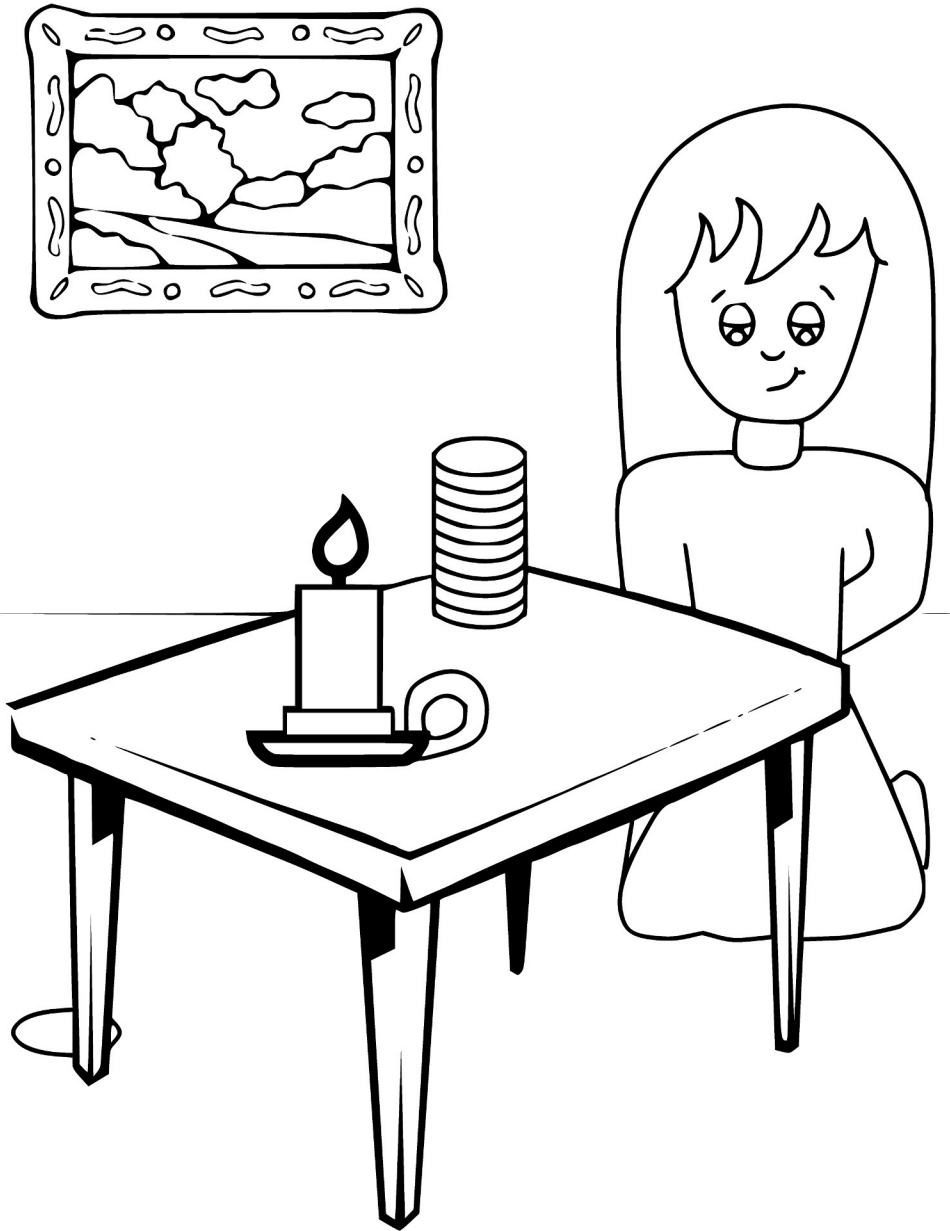
She had many other coins already on the table, but she kept looking for the one that was lost - then she found it!

She invited her friends to share the good news: "I found the lost coin!"

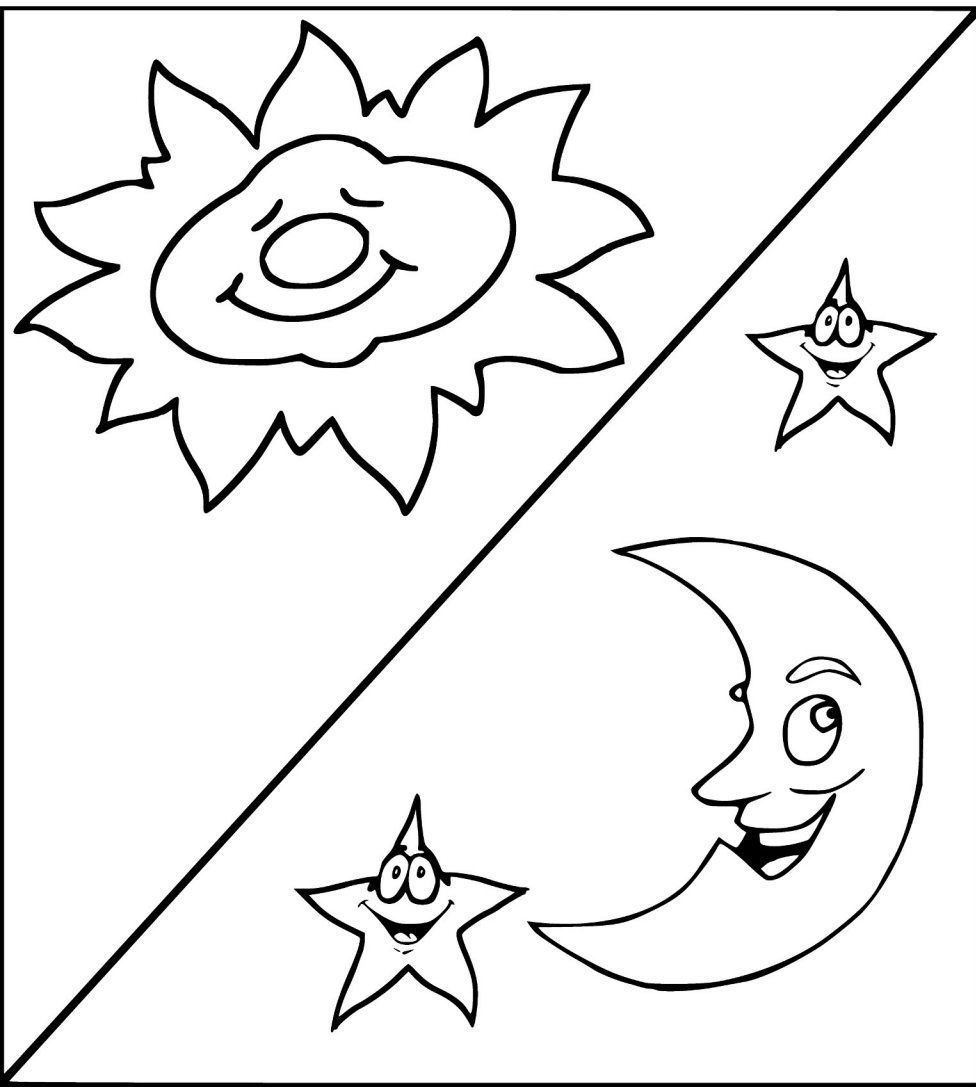

## The Prodigal Son

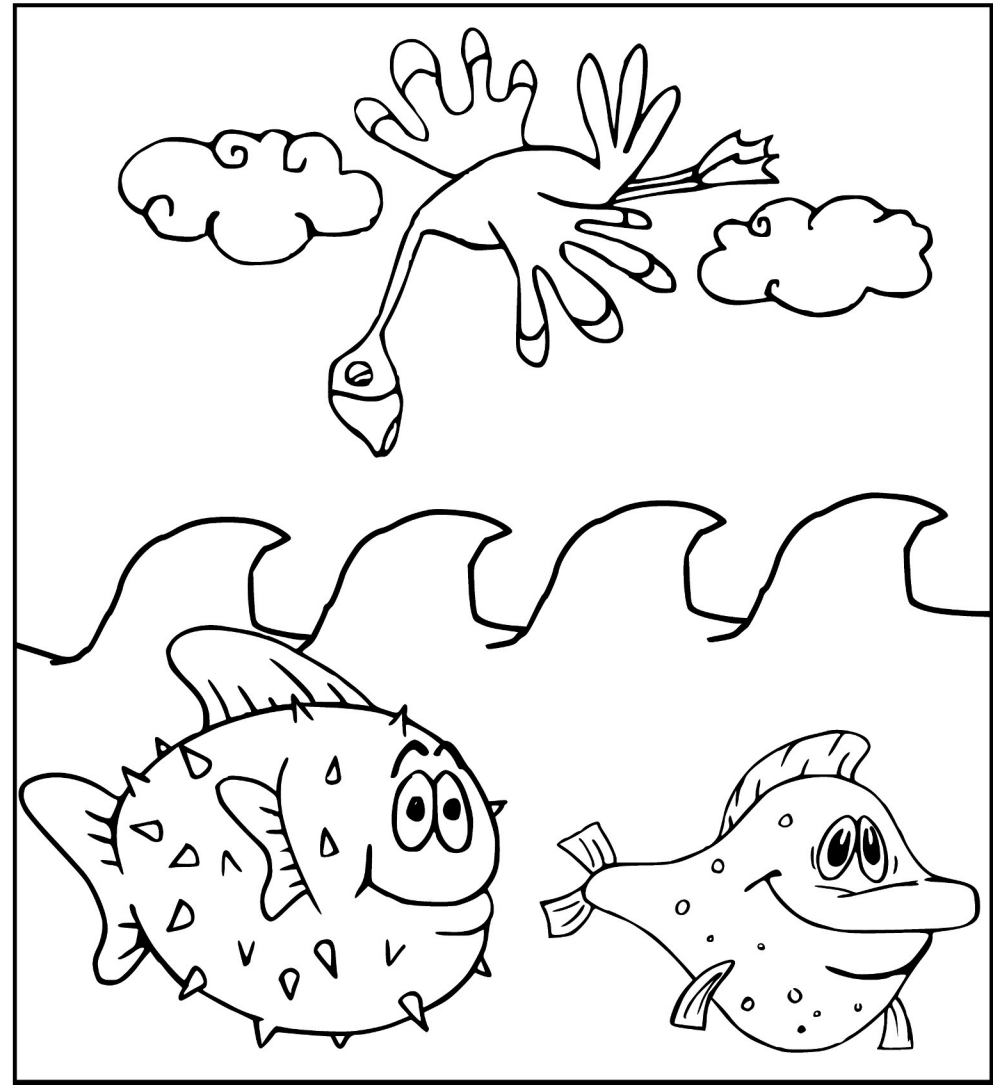
One day a man decided to go and live in the world all by himself. He told his father that he would never return.

The man did not have a good life in the world, and one day he thought "I know! I will go back to my father's place and work for him. He is good to his workers.

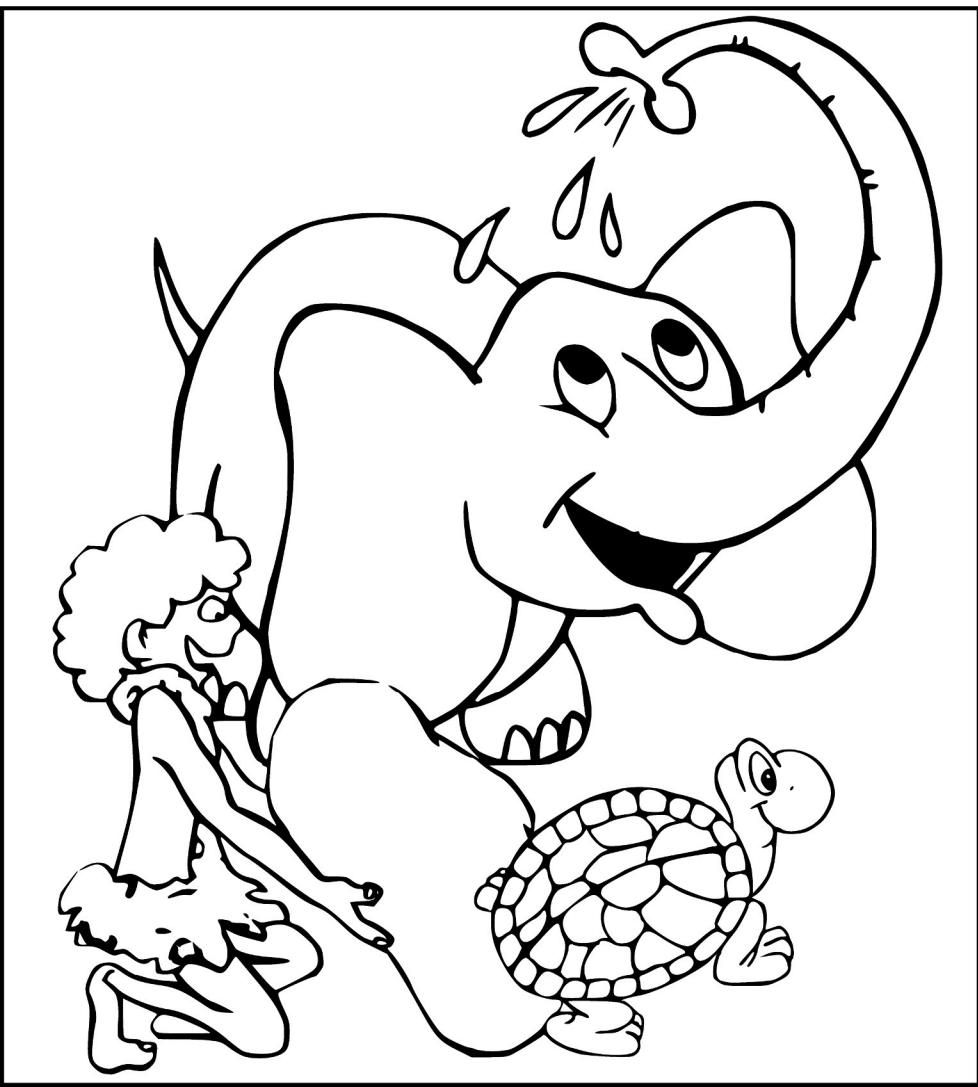
When his father saw him, he ran out to meet his long-lost son, kissing him: "My son! You've returned! Come, we must have a great feast to celebrate!"

## The Good Samaritan

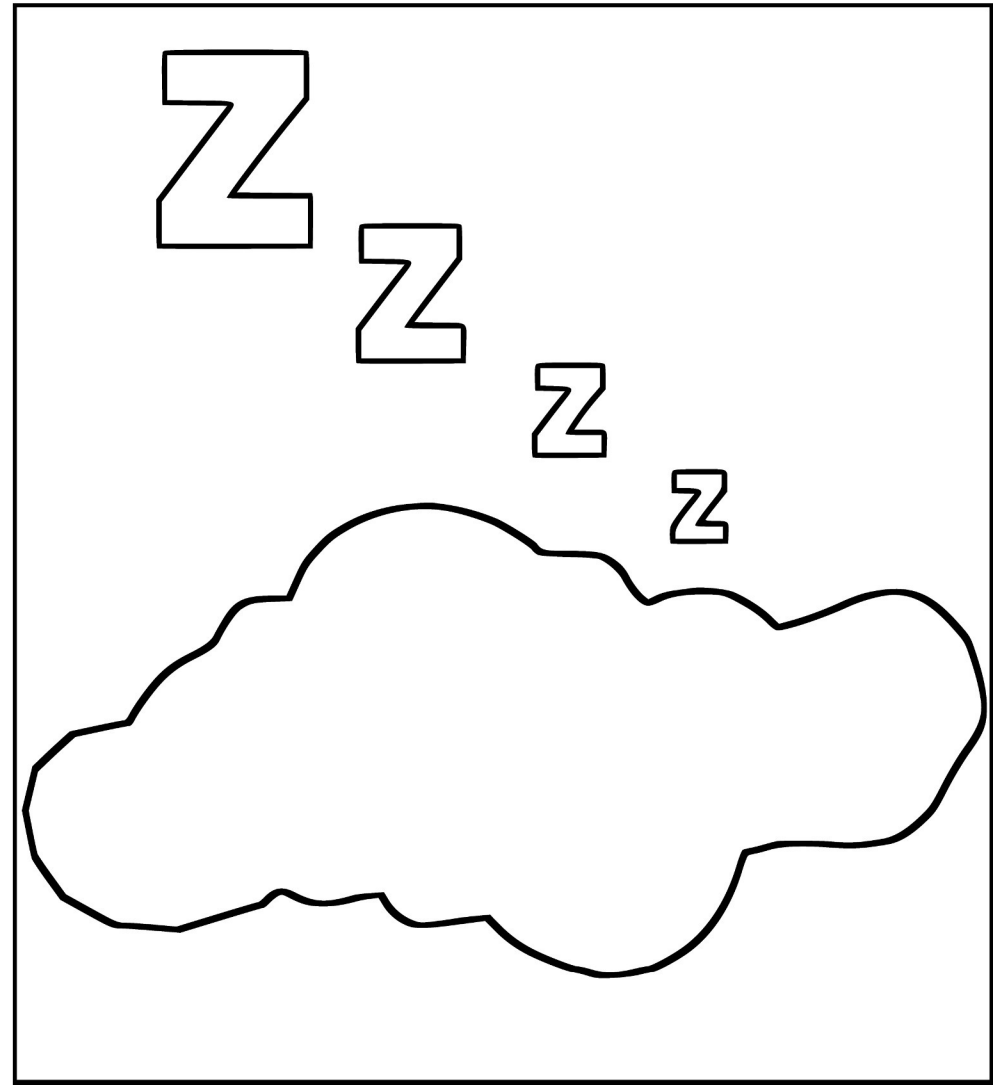
Jews believed they were better than Samaritans. One day a Jewish man was attacked and robbed, and almost died!

A Jewish Priest saw him and crossed the road. He did not want to help. Another Jew too saw him almost dead, and crossed the road to ignore him.

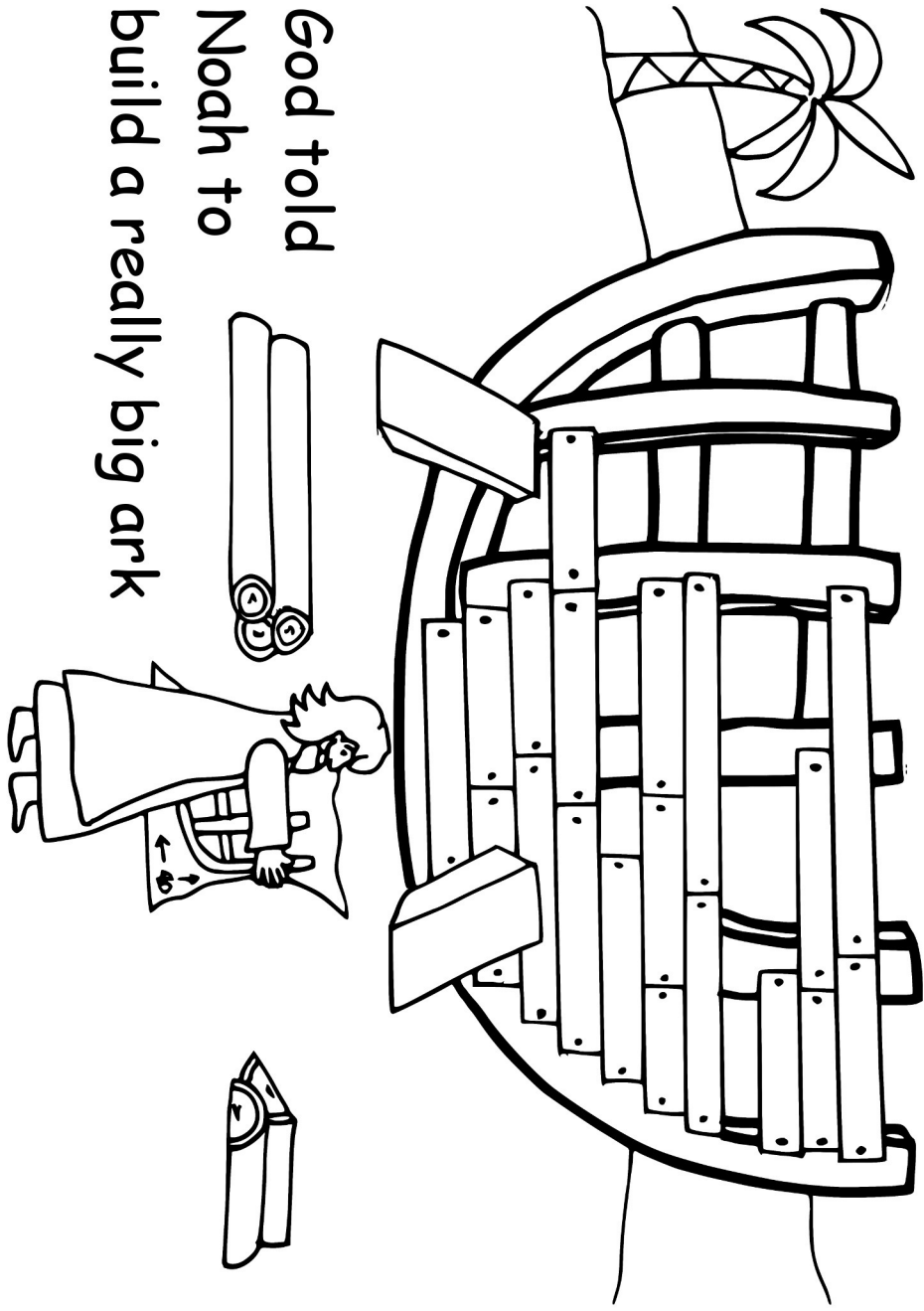
Then a Samaritan came and put bandages and ointment on him, and took him to a traveller's inn, giving money to the inn keeper to look after the man.

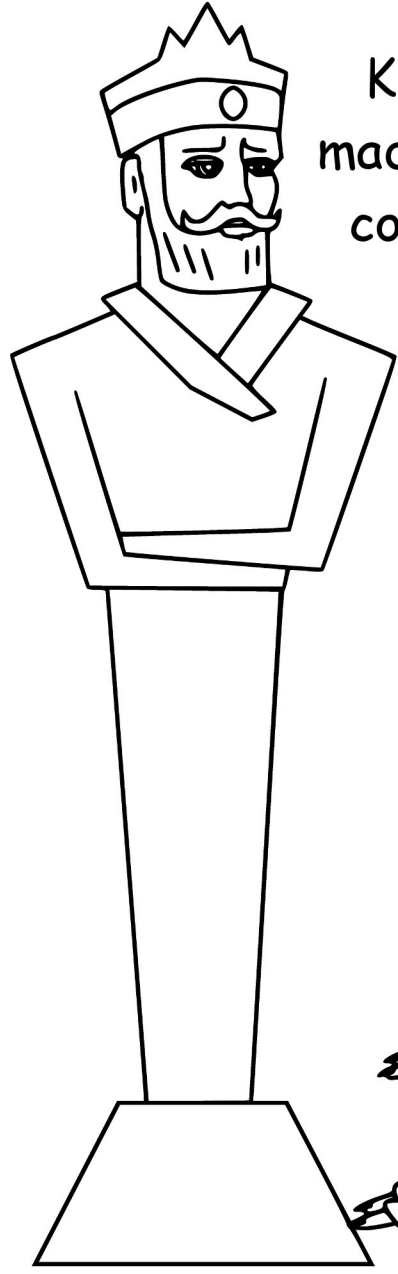


These three men were working for king Nebuchadnezzar in Babylon. They worshipped God faithfully.

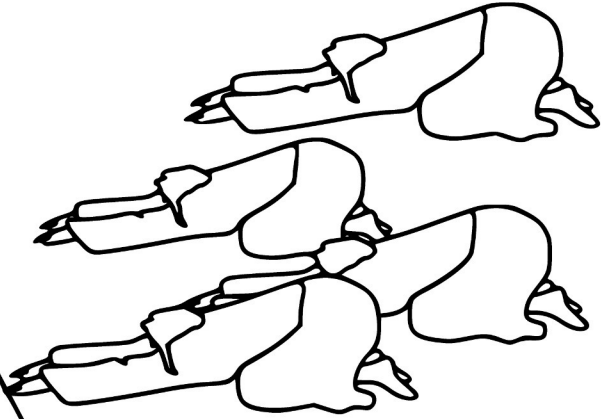

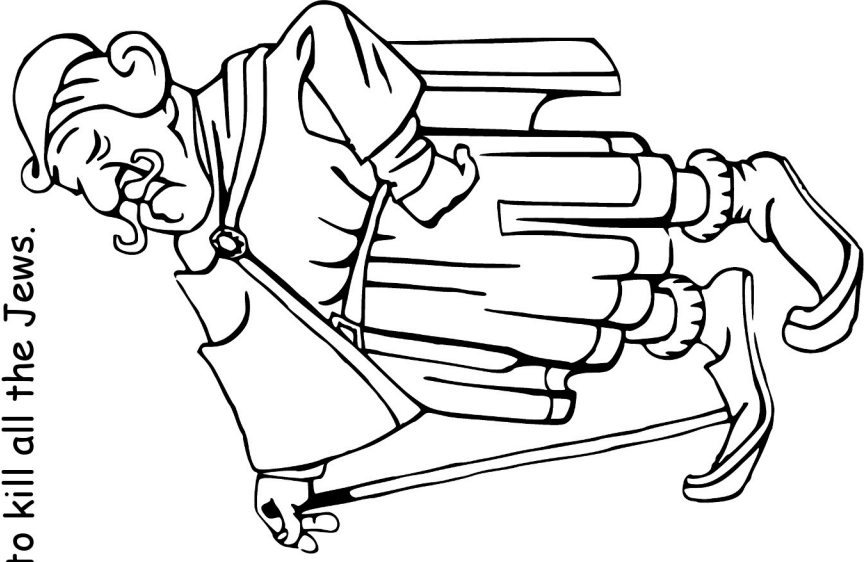
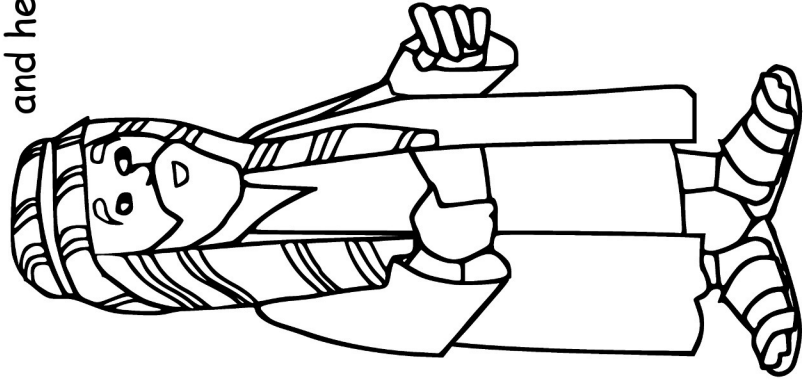




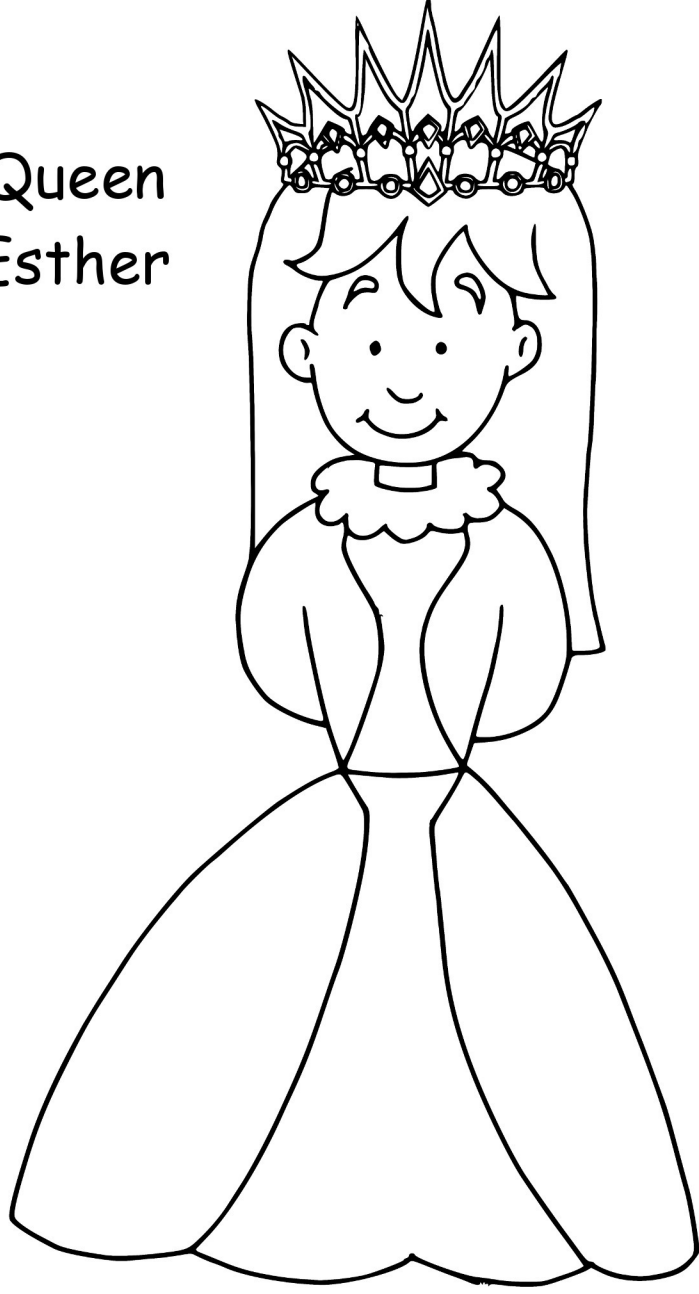
King Nebuchadnezzar

to bow down to it.



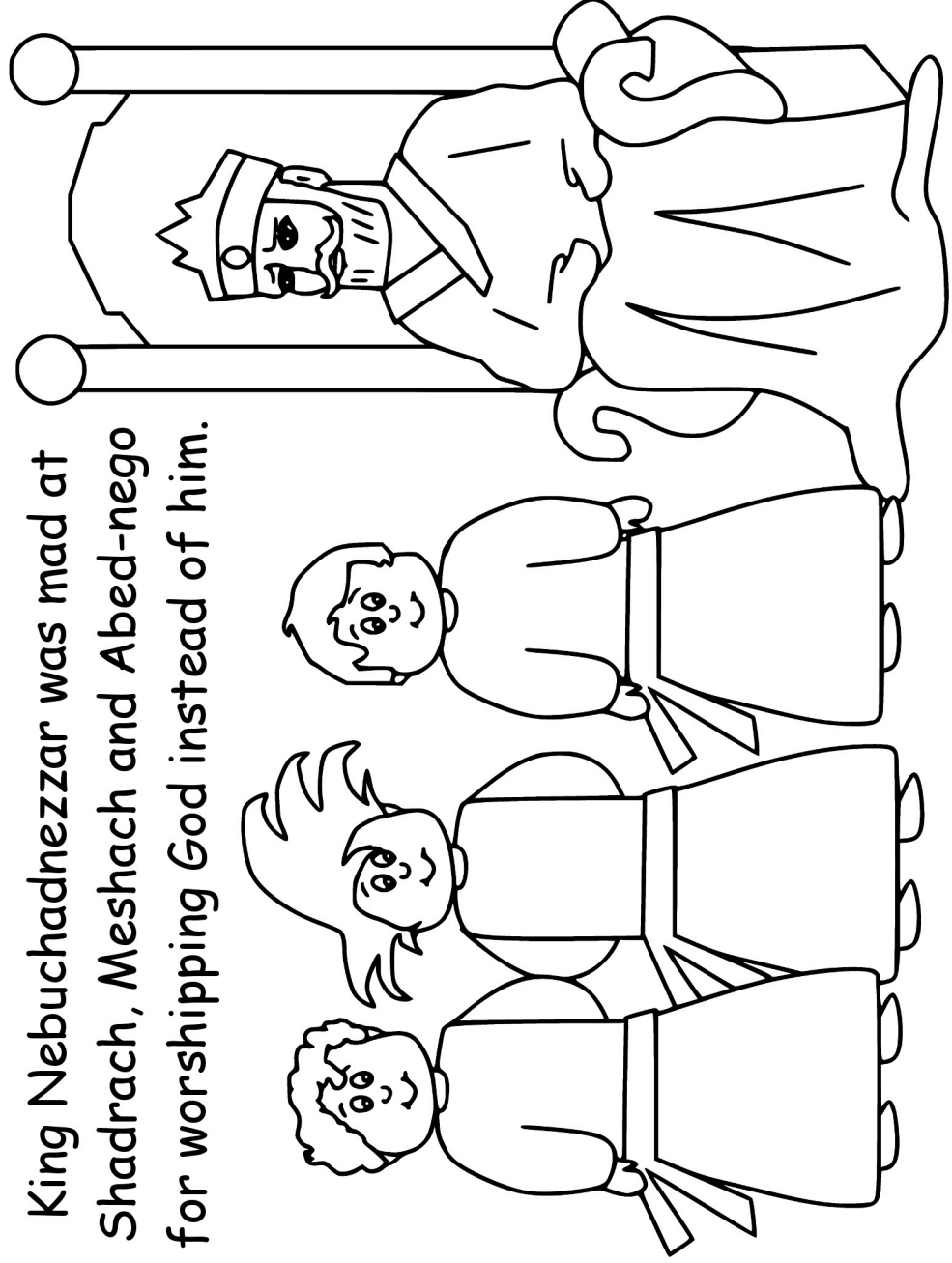
Haman was an important man to king Xerxes. He wanted Mordecai to bow to him,

and he wanted to kill all the Jews.

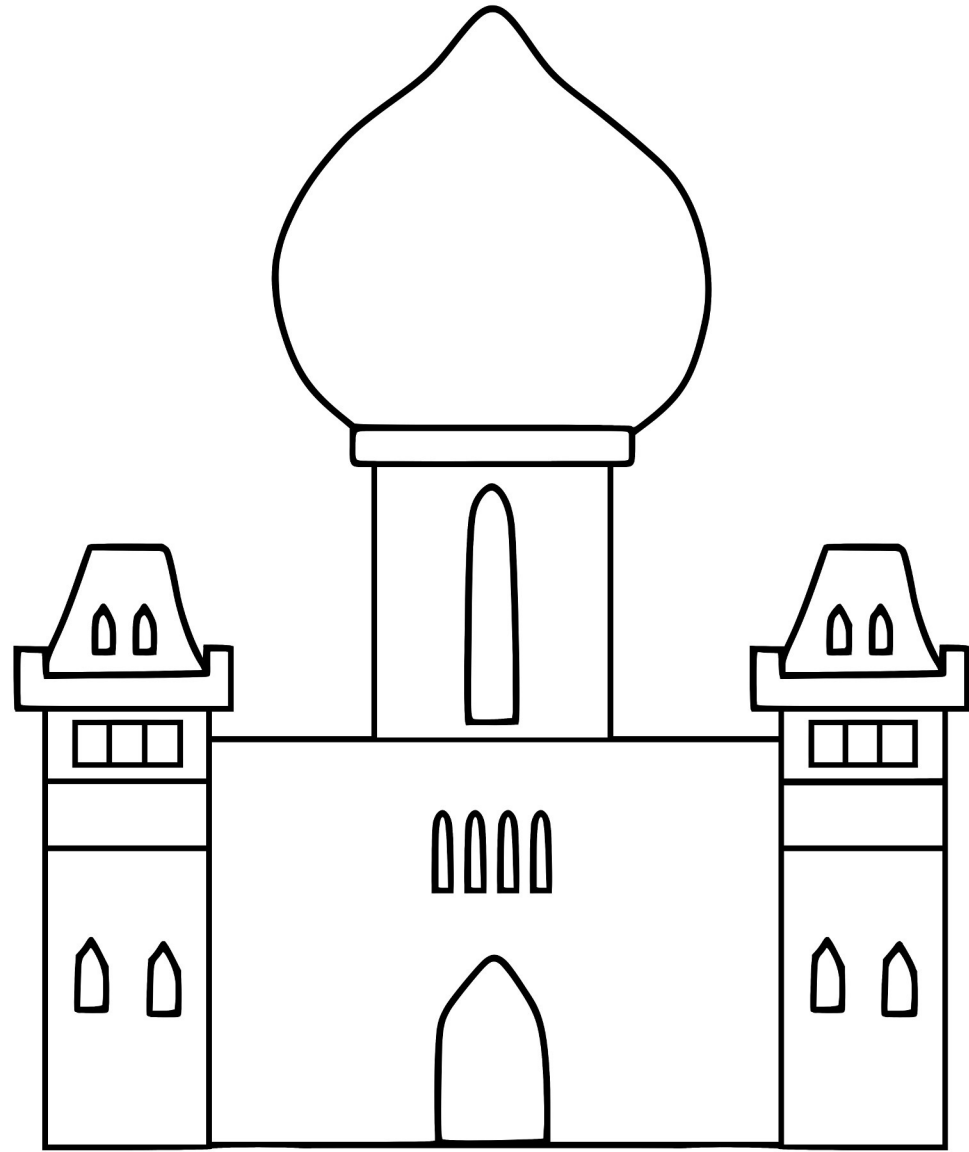


Queen

King Xerxes liked Esther the most, and he gave her the crown to become the new Queen.

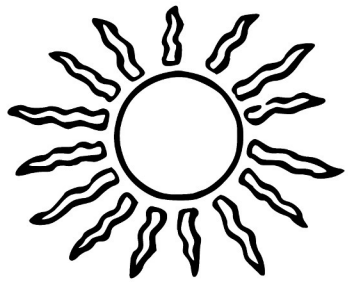
Hegai looked after all the ladies that lived at the palace. He liked Esther and gave her special food and beauty treatments.
